## New Scholarship Application (Vocational or Non-Credit Courses)

### IMPORTANT:

- Scholarship application with all items in the checklist must be submitted by **8PM on March 15, 2018**
- Scholarship applications **must be complete** to be considered for review by the Committee
- Scholarship process is **competitive** so a submitted application does not guarantee that an applicant receives an award

### ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must have passed two (2) consecutive Carlos Rosario School semesters
  - If currently in your 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, applicant must pass current semester
- Successful completion of a Career Academy Program at Carlos Rosario School

- Completed Application Form
- GED (*English or Spanish*) Transcript, US High School Diploma, or Credential Evaluation report
- Proof of 75% attendance during the current semester (*request through current teacher*)
- Proof of submitted application to vocational or non-credit program (*if applicable*)
- Proof of application to FAFSA (*if eligible*)
- Filled in financial worksheet (*see worksheet in packet*)
- Letter of recommendation from a current Carlos Rosario School Career Academy teacher
- Letter of recommendation from employer, friend, or professional contact
- Completed Essay #1: Describe how experiences from your life have prepared you for the program you want to study in college (*Tell us about your long-term career plan*). (500 words or more//typed essay)
- Completed Essay #2: What do you think is the most important challenge in your community and how have you worked in the past to solve that challenge (*Also explain how you plan use your education to solve the challenge in the future*). (250 words or more//typed essay)
- Submit all the documents above to the Student Transition Services
