Protocol #3 Face Masks



Masking is Required if you are closer than 6 ft.

You may remove your mask if you:

- can maintain 6 ft. distance
- are actively eating or drinking
- are alone in your office or space



6 ft. distancing is encouraged whenever possible

You are strongly Encouraged to ***Always*** Wear a Mask if:

- You are not vaccinated or not up to date with your COVID Vaccination.
- You are immunocompromised or share a home with people who are at risk for severe illness.
- And of course, we support anyone to wear a mask regardless of personal circumstance.



Protocol #4 Sanitize your Hands Often

- There are multiple hand sanitizer dispensers throughout our campuses.
- If you cannot find a dispenser, please ask CR staff and we will help.



Protocol #5

Elevators, Staff Lounge and Restrooms

Elevators, staff lounges and restrooms are open for regular use.

Just remember to wear a mask if closer than 6 ft.
